We provide a range of specialist services that aim to make people safe, help them rebuild their lives and prevent future abuse.

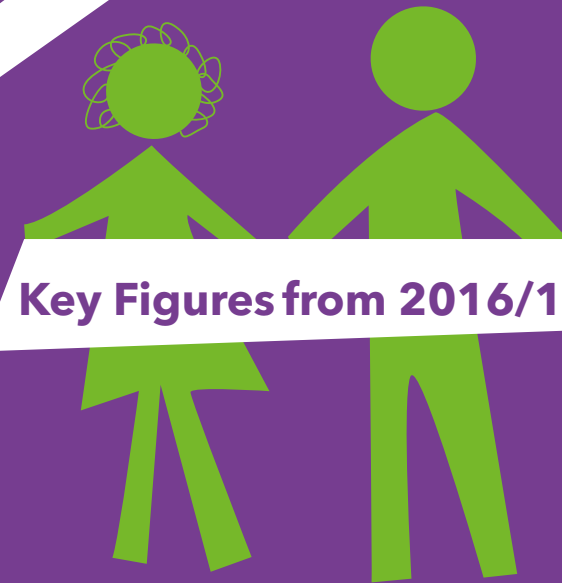

What had they experienced?

Adults

On average, adult clients experienced **4.4 years** of abuse before contacting Oasis

17% had experienced threats to kill

14% experienced strangulation or suffocation

19% had thoughts of 'ending it all' or had attempted suicide

"I feel stronger and more in control of making positive decisions. I'm looking forward to the start of a new chapter in my life."



Children

80% of the children we mentor have directly witnessed the abuse of someone else

49% have directly experienced emotional abuse

38% have directly experienced physical abuse

36% of the children we mentor have a mental health need



What did we do?

"I can't thank my keyworker enough, words will never be enough. She has done so much to help us."

"I'm so glad we had you guys as support. You were there for us when we needed you."



Working with High-Risk Victims

372 high risk victims of domestic abuse were given support and safety planning

90% of high risk victims that we helped had a significant reduction in risk

88% of high risk victims that we helped had improved emotional wellbeing



Early Intervention and Prevention Team

165 young people were supported through 1-to-1 mentoring and coaching approaches

391 young people in schools participated in **Just so you kNOW** workshops about grooming, consent and assertive behaviours



Short Term Interventions

112 people were supported with brief outreach intervention

136 people dropped in for support and were seen by specialist staff in the **One Stop Shop**

90 clients were supported to case closure in court with **89** of them having a successful court outcome



Training other professionals

In 2016/17 Oasis provided **free training to 490 local professionals** as part of our mission is to ensure victims of abuse get a good service no matter who they approach.

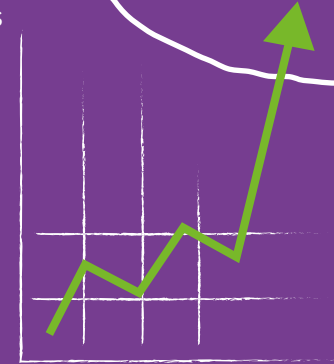
